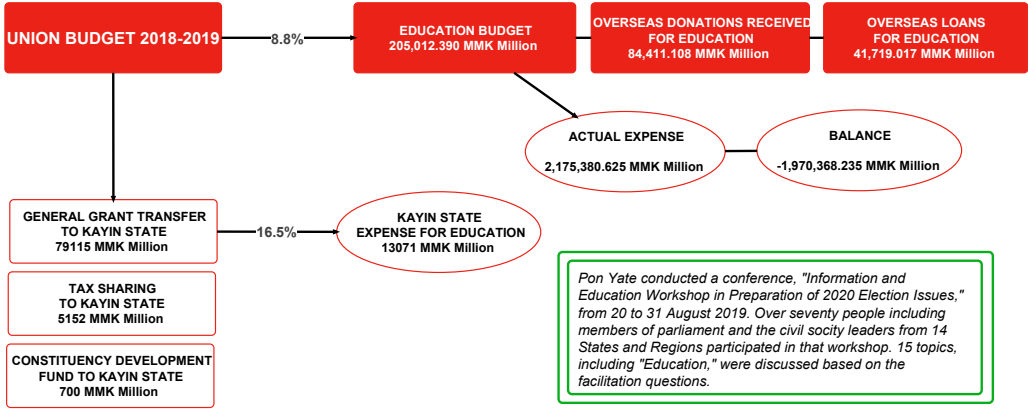




EDUCATIONAL INFORMATION IN KAYIN STATE

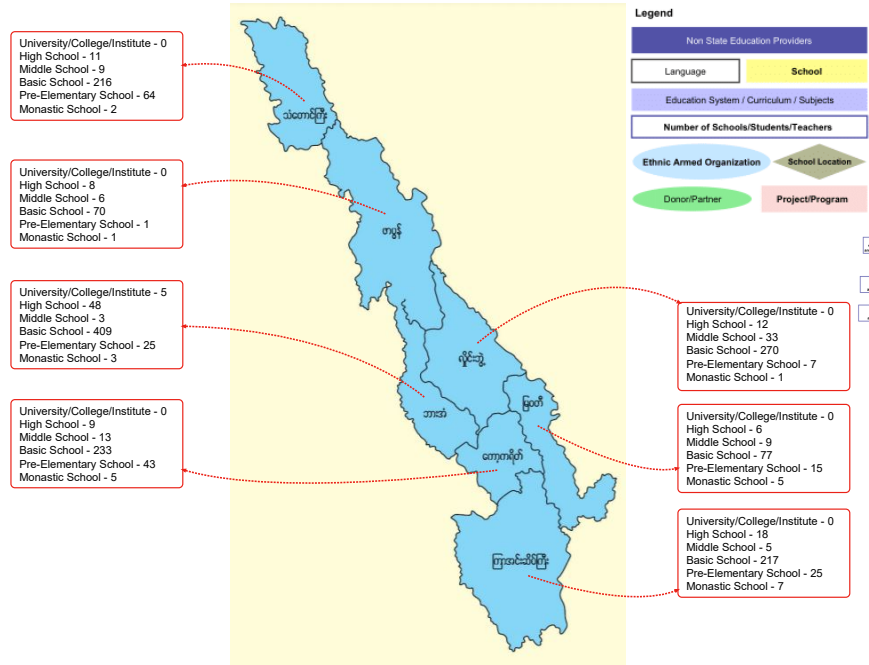


Pon Yate conducted a conference, "Information and Education Workshop in Preparation of 2020 Election Issues," from 20 to 31 August 2019. Over seventy people including members of parliament and the civil society leaders from 14 States and Regions participated in that workshop. 15 topics, including "Education," were discussed based on the facilitation questions.

Findings and Recommendations from the workshop

- Value added education system and the system reform with community participation.
- Education system reform with community participation.
- Government should acknowledge the community schools and the formal education run by the Karen Education Department.
- Decentralized education policy.
- Need practical education. (Updating curriculum in line with reality.)
- Government should connect with private schools to support growing human resources for the country and need regulation for the private schools such as pay rate and tuition fees.
- Need research and assessment for the advantages and disadvantages of tutoring.
- Government should provide awareness to parents and the community on the importance of education through platforms such as TV programs, radio channels and media.
- Entrance for higher education should not be decided by scores, but by the students' interests.
- Review gender ratio by sector; Education, Military training, Nursing training, small-scale business
